**Prologue:** A fast out and back on River Road with a short finishing climb up Mt Werner Rd, tt equipment allowed.

**Circuit Race:** 4.5 mile loop on smooth pavement with rolling terrain, limited traffic and uphill finish.

**Road Race:** A challenging course with lots of climbing, technical descents, and long finishing climb

**Criterium:** Four Corners, clean pavement, a flat finish and cash primes.



### Race Notes:

- Promoter reserves the right to adjust times/distances. Refer to the race technical guide for final details, to be posted mid August.
- All ACA Stage Race rules apply, MUST BE A licensed ACA or FIAC rider to participate, your USAC category will translate, but USAC riders will need to purchase ACA day licenses (\$10 per day). No ACA annual licenses will be sold on site.
- Stage Race rules require you start and complete each day of racing to continue on, riders who DNF or DNS for any stage are out of the race. Riders who do not finish a stage for whatever reason will not be allowed to start the next day and will be listed as DNF in the results, no exceptions.

### Registration:

- Online Registration closes Tuesday August 31<sup>st</sup> (midnight), mail entries must be postmarked by Thursday August 26<sup>th</sup>. NO REFUNDS.
- Pre-registration only, online at [bikereg.com](http://bikereg.com) or by mail to SSSR, C/O Corey Piscopo, PO Box 773023, Steamboat Springs, CO 80477 Please include completed and signed 2010 ACA Athlete's Entry Form/Standard Release with mail-in entries. Make Checks payable to: Steamboat Stage Race.
- Minimum fields of 15 riders, promoter reserves the right to reduce the prize list, combine fields or cancel the event if field minimums are not met. Maximum field size of 65 riders.

### Directions:

- **Prologue** Parking at the Meadows lot off of Mt. Werner Rd. From US40 turn onto Pine Grove Rd and follow signs to parking area. Race Start is located 2 miles from parking area, finish is immediately next to the parking area.
- **Stage 1** Located at Marabou Ranch, 6 miles west of downtown. Travel west on US-40 for 4 miles and then turn right onto CR-42. Follow CR-42 up two hills and follow signs/volunteers to parking at Marabou Ranch.
- **Stage 2** Starts 6 miles west of town on CR-33A. From downtown by bike follow 13<sup>th</sup> St. past the old train depot west onto CR-33. 5.5 miles from town look for CR-33A on your right and follow signs to parking. By car take US-40 west of town for ~7 miles and turn left on CR-33A, Follow signs to parking. 33-A will be neutral rollout to the pavement on CR-33.
- **Stage 3** is a downtown criterium located on Oak St, Pine St, 4<sup>th</sup> St, & 8<sup>th</sup> St. Parking is available around town including Howelsen Hill. It is also a short ride on the bike path from hotels and condos.
